

GUEST CONDUCTORS



KATY ABRAHAM is a musician and conductor in the Winnipeg music community. Her love of choral music started from a young age and blossomed as a chorister in St. James School Divisional Choirs, University of Manitoba Singers and Concert Choir, Manitoba Provincial Honour Choirs (now MB Sings), Prairie Voices and Horizon choirs. Katy has taught choir at the middle school, high school, and community choir levels and currently co-directs Horizon choir alongside Leanne Cooper-Carrier. Katy has a passion for building community through music making, which she shares with her students in Seven Oaks, singers in Horizon and actors in Recycled Talent Productions. A total theory nerd, Katy loves a good rhythm puzzle and analyzing crunchy chords. When not making music, she is busy chasing after her two young kiddos, taking long walks (sometimes on the golf course), and swimming laps.



CLINT MCLACHLAN is from Brandon, Manitoba, and is an avid teacher and performer. Clint holds a Master of Vocal Performance from the University of Western Ontario, and a Bachelor of Music Performance and an Education After Degree from Brandon University. Clint has enjoyed working in the Westman Region as a clinician, adjudicator, assistant conductor for Konektis Choir, and vocal director and orchestra conductor for several Mecca Musicals. DR. JAMIE HILLMAN is a Canadian and American musician, active as a conductor, singer, pianist, music educator, and composer-arranger. He conducts the U of T MacMillan Singers and leads the master's and doctoral degree programs in Choral Conducting. Professor Hillman is a Senior Fellow at Massey College and is cross listed faculty in Emmanuel College's Master of Sacred Music program.
